MINUTES OF THE BUSINESS SESSION

MARCH 23, 1990

CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE

The business session of the 1990 GHSLA meeting was held during a luncheon in the Roosevelt West Function room of the Chattanooga Choo Choo on Friday, March 23, 1990. Jett McCann, GHSLA chair called the meeting to order at 1 p.m. It was noted that this year marks the 20th anniversary of GHSLA.

The 1989 minutes were corrected to state that Gail Anderson had presented the GHSLA UPDATE editors report. The minutes were then approved.

OLD BUSINESS

GHSLA Treasurer's Report

Betty Clements presented the treasurer's report.

GHSLA UPDATE Editors Report

Gail Anderson reported that three issues were published during the year. Copies were sent to all GHSLA members and other health science librarians in the state. Thanks were given to Tom Basler, Director, Medical College of Georgia Library, for underwriting printing and postage costs of the UPDATE.

Continuing Education Committee Report

Jett McCann reported for Mamie Bell. The demand for continued online searching instruction remains high. The membership of THESLA agreed. Therefore, CE 456: Advanced Skills for Online Searchers was offered at this year's meeting.

Consortia

Martha Watkins reported for the committee. The North Georgia Health Science Library Consortium had its organizational meeting on February 5, 1990 with Susan Seay directing the effort. Four hospitals were represented and four others expressed interest in the undertaking. A union list of serials is a designated project. The Consortium Committee produced a supplement to the GHSLA Consortia Directory 1989 which was distributed at the meeting. The Committee also sponsored a session at the GHSLA/ THESLA meeting in Chattanooga on "Sustaining Partnerships".

Membership Committee

Shelley Davis reported that there are 89 GHSLA members, 69 personal and 20 institutional.

Resource Sharing Committee

The five interlibrary loan workshops given in conjunction with the Consortium Committee in the fall of 1989 drew a total of 93 participants. Workshops were held in Atlanta, Dalton, Savannah, Macon and Augusta. The workshops were very well received and GHSLA gained twelve new members from among the registrants. A resource sharing directory including institutions identified through the workshops and other Georgia health science libraries is in process. The possibility of offering the workshop on a regular basis with standardized content and instructional materials is being considered.

Program Committee Report

The first joint meeting of the Georgia Health Sciences Library Association and the Tennessee Health Sciences Library Association was held March 21-23, 1990 in Chattanooga, Tennessee at the Chattanooga Choo Choo. Lynne L. Yeomans was the Tennessee Program Planner. Donna Flake, the Georgia Planner and Patti Deaux handled the Georgia details. Margarette Koplan-Claypool served as the local arrangements person.

Miriam Libbey Committee

Jett McCann reported that since the 1990 meeting was a joint meeting with THESLA, this would not be the appropriate time to honor Mrs. Libbey. This will be done at the 1991 meeting instead. GHSLA has also been asked to contribute to the costs of publishing a festschrift in honor of Mrs. Libbey which is being prepared by the Atlanta Health Science Libraries Consortium.

1990 GHSLA Annual Meeting Business Session

NEW BUSINESS

The prepared slate of nominees for 1991 was read to the meeting by the Chair of the Nominating Committee. The slate was approved.

Executive Committee Report

Jett McCann reported that an invitation was received from the Florida Health Science Library Association to join with them for a combined Florida/Georgia meeting to be hosted by Georgia in Savannah in the spring of 1991. The Executive Committee decided that a joint meeting with Florida in 1991 would not be in the best interest of the association.

Carol Burns of the Health Sciences Center Library of Emory University stated that according to the bylaws, GHSLA archival records should be kept at Emory University.

A message of congratulations was sent to Ken Robichaux and Ann Kabler on the occasion of their April 28th marriage.

Introduction of guests:

Jett McCann introduced special guest Faith Meakin, Region 2, Regional Medical Library (SEARMLS), who presented attendees with an update of the RML. Jean Shipman, Region 2 Regional Medical Library and Janet Di Claudio, Candler Hospital, Savannah, presented the workshop on "Creative Problem Solving".

The meeting was adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
