From Atlanta: Take I-75 North to Exit #268 onto I-575 North toward Canton. I-575 North becomes Zell Miller Mountain Pkwy. (GA-515). Follow GA-515 North until it becomes U.S. Highway 76 East to Young Harris, GA. Brasstown Valley Resort is located one mile on the right past the town of Young Harris.

### From I-75 North


Take US Route 76 East and continue to follow toward Ellijay, GA to US 76/515. Follow US Route 76/515 to Young Harris, GA. Brasstown Valley Resort is located one mile on the right past the town of Young Harris.

### From I-85 South

Take I-985 toward Gainesville, GA. Then follow US Routes 129/11 to Cleveland, GA. In Cleveland, GA make a right turn onto GA Route 75 toward Hiawassee, GA. Make a left turn onto US Route 76 toward Young Harris. Brasstown Valley Resort is located on left one mile before the town of Young Harris.

### From I-85 North

Take US Route 76 through Clemson, SC toward the town of Westminister, SC and follow US 76 through Clayton, GA to Young Harris, GA. Brasstown Valley Resort is located on left one mile before the town of Young Harris.
