


A xerox machine is available in the Medical Records Department for the patrons use at 10c per page for the first 25-pages, and 5c per page thereafter.






National Library of Medicine and Library of Congress classification systems used.



CIRCULATION POLICIES:

Periodicals: Do not check out. Books: One week, with three renewals if there is no reserve placed. AV Equipment: Generally loaned only to Emory and Grady faculty, staff, and students.

AV Software: Most items, one week with three renewals. Emory Medical Television Network videocassettes available for loan through the library at no cost to members and for a fee to non-members.

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Multi-Media Center is located on the lower level of Brawley Hall at the corner of Lee Street and Westview Drive. It is the resource arm of the School of Medicine.

The School is a member of the Atlanta University Center which has a combined total resource of approximately 500,000 volumes. In addition the Multi-Media Center is also a member of the Atlanta Health Sciences Library Consortium and the National Biomedical Communications Network. The A. W. Calhoun Collection is available for use via the Southeastern Regional Medical Library Network.

B. LIBRARY USE

All faculty, staff and students of the School of Medicine at Morehouse College and the faculty of Morehouse, may borrow and use the Center Collection.

1. CIRCULATION

All materials borrowed from the Center are charged out at the Circulation Desk. Each borrower must have a valid Identification card. Loan Regulations are:

- Periodicals (bound) circulate for three (3) days.
- Periodicals (unbound) circulate overnight only.
- Books circulate for two (2) weeks.
- Reserve materials circulate overnight and are due at 9:00 A.M. the following morning or 2:00 P.M. Sunday.
- Abstracts, Indexes and Reference books Do Not Circulate.

2. RESERVE BOOKS

Required materials for course assignments are housed at the Circulation Desk. A file is located at the desk which lists materials by course number, by main entry, and by subjects. These materials are for use in the Multi-Media Center but may circulate for overnight use at 9:00 P.M Sunday thru Thursday and 4:00 P.M. Friday thru Saturday. A fine of \$.50 for each hour overdue is charge.

3. OVERDUES

Notices are sent weekly regarding all overdue items. You will automatically be billed the third week. A processing charge of \$5.00 will be levied for each item in addition to the cost of materials regardless of the return of the materials.

C. HEALTH SCIENCE LIBRARIES COLLECTIONS

The bulk of the collection is serials because it contains the most recent updates in all areas of the health sciences. Most Health Sciences Libraries Collection will contain 60-70% serials.

2. KEY GUIDES TO THE CURRENT MEDICAL SERIAL LITERATURE

a. Index Medicus and Cumulated Index Medicus 1960-

A monthly index, with annual cumulations. <u>Index Medicus</u> is published by the National Library of Medicine and provides a current and comprehensive author and subject approach to material presented in over 4,000 international periodicals in basic and clinical medicine and related fields. Each month there is a section devoted to review articles, the <u>Bibliography of Medical Reviews</u>, which cumulates in the annual issue of <u>Index Medicus</u>. In order to choose the best and most specific subject headings to use, it is advisable to consult the most current edition of MeSH (Medical Subject Headings). MeSH is the list of subject headings used in the Index Medicus (IM).

b. Current Catalog of the National Library of Medicine 1967-

This is the index to the monographic (book) literature received by the National Library of Medicine. It provides an author, title, and subject approach to books in the Basic Sciences and Clinical Medicine.

3. PERIODICALS

The most current issues of periodicals are shelved alphabetically on the <u>south</u> side of the Center. The most recent issue is displayed on the slanted shelf with remaining issues below. Bound volumes are shelved at the rear to the <u>east</u> side and are arranged alphabetically by title. Some unbound issue are also housed with bound volumes.

4. CARD CATALOG

The card catalog lists alphabetically by author, title and subject, materials available in the Center. It is a divided catalog with authors and titles in one section and subjects in another. Mylar card overlays are placed on main entry cards for items which are on Reserve and on the reference shelf.

5. BOOKS

Books are shelved around the outer walls beginning at ______ and end south wall just before periodicals. The Center uses the National Library of Medicine and Library of Congress classification systems, materials are shelved by these numbers.

D. INFORMATION SERVICES

 <u>Reference Questions</u>-The Library answers ready reference type questions which utilize materials in this Library or in the Region. The Library also responds to telephone inquiries and prepares subject bibliographies using Index Medicus. By means of the Biomedical Communications Network, computerized subject Searches are created upon demand via the Medline Center at Emory. Initial charge is \$7.50.

- 2. <u>Bibliographic Verification</u>-The Library performs bibliographic verifications of reference for publications by faculty members.
- 3. <u>Interlibrary Loans</u>-Material not available locally will be obtained through the Southeastern Regional Library and the National Library of Medicine.
- 4. Photocopy Services and Interlibrary Loans are not yet available to other institutions.

PATRONS

The resources of the medical library are available to the health professionals of the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital. The library staff attempts to answer the information needs of health practitioners by serving as a source of reference, study and instructional materials for patient care, research, professional growth, and personal continuing education.



JOURNALS



The journal holdings of the library are available to the Medical / Dental and hospital staff. The library does not circulate journals. Photocopies of individual articles are furnished upon request or users are welcome to copy any articles that are work related. When a given journal is not in the holdings, the library will seek to obtain the requested article from another local library or via interlibrary loan from the nearest library owning the material.

BOOKS



Loan of circulating books for a weekend or one week may be arranged. Reference books are used in the library; they do not circulate so they may be available at all times. Books are subject to recall if urgently needed. There are no overdue fines, but users must reimburse the library for lost or damaged books.

DATA BASES



The Library maintains a computer terminal to perform online searches of the National Library of Medicine data bases. References to articles from 1966 to the present can be searched and printed on-line.

AV MATERIALS



There are two slide projectors in the library that can be checked out by the Medical / Dental and hospital staff. The library must be notified in advance so users can be sure of having one when needed.

PATIENT SLIDES



The library maintains a collection of patients' slides filed by hospital number, patient name or disease. Medical / Dental and hospital personnel may check out the slides Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. using the proper sign out sheet. The slides must be returned within a reasonable amount of time but individuals may duplicate slides if needed for more than two weeks.

GENERAL INFORMATION

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
Recommendations from health professionals on books or journals to be added to the library collection are encouraged.
